CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

As the story goes, Sigmund Freud and his wife took their little daughter to a park. The park was pretty busy and Freud met some friends while his wife and daughter went further ahead. After some time, the distraught wife came running saying that the daughter had wandered off and was nowhere to be found. Freud asked her to calm down and recollect any instructions she had given her daughter. The wife said that she had merely mentioned that the daughter could play as she likes, except that she should not go near the well in the park. Freud held his wife by the arm and walked her toward the well. They found the daughter playing blissfully next to it!

Not wanting someone to do something and getting them not to do it are two completely different things. The surest way to make people do something is to ban it. And if it is children you are dealing with, your friendly neighbourhood school headmistress will tell you to perish that thought! We just aren't smart enough, she would say!

CLINICAL PRACTICE

As a developmental behavioural pediatrician, I have been writing down 'limit screen time' as a part of my clinical prescription for every patient for over twelve years now.



A significant amount of my consulting time is (well) spent pleading, cajoling and convincing parents about the short and long term dangers of digital media. Four years ago, I was addressing parents at a fund raising event for a Municipal hospital extolling parents about the dangers of unrestricted screen time- I firmly believe that stopping screen time for children below two-three years and limiting it thereafter, along with a good 10-hours-anight sleep, will help to an extent control the endemic proportion disorders like autism and ADHD are assuming. Someone recorded a video and the clip went viral on social media. I received numerous calls of gratitude from known and unknown people. A particular group of people trolled me saying there was no evidence (in the western academic circles) and that I was making them feel responsible and guilty for their children watching screens! Self-styled advocacy takes various hues!

A GROWING BODY OF RESEARCH

There is ample evidence now that excessive screen time is implicated in serious developmental and behavioural abnormalities in children and adolescents (Kushima M, 2022 Apr) (Madigan S, 2019) Mar). Internet gaming addiction is turning out to be an alarming condition with serious consequences to physical and mental and financial health with implications impacting family, social and academic dynamics as well as opening up dark windows into cyberbullying and cybercrime (Şalvarlı, 2022). The Indian Academy of Pediatrics in a consensus statement as well as a Parent Advisory Guideline, has enunciated the matter very well in the public domain.

SCREENS AND THE PANDEMIC

However, one realizes that merely speaking about the issue or creating awareness does not actually end up cultivating the desired behavior. At times. it does end up making people feel overwhelmed, guilty or frustrated and, indeed sometimes reinforces the undesirable behaviours. What is of paramount importance is guiding, mentoring, encouraging and when indicated, offering medical and paramedical interventions to enable people to adopt the new behavior. Merely banning or even creating a scare, especially at a time when children were locked in and schools were/are online, is not the solution. During the pandemic, some one made a cartoon which shows a bespectacled 'academic' looking boy mocking the world - "You said mobiles are not allowed in school: now the school is in the mobile!"

SCREEN TIME RECOMMENDATIONS

On a general level, the earlier we start the better are the results. Children below the age of 18–24 months should not be exposed to any type of screen with the exception of live video calls with relatives. At New Horizons, we recommend the latter should be enabled on a Television or Desktop screen, thus avoiding the mobile device being handed over to the toddler. Screen time for children between the age of 2 and 5 years should not exceed 1 hour; and always supervised (multiple guidelines and consensus statements).





MANAGING SCREEN TIMES: EXPERIENCES AT NEW HORIZONS

For older children and adolescents, it is important to balance screen time with other activities that are required for overall development. Due to online schooling, educational-screen time became inevitable (it now threatens to carry on as a legacy of the dark, screen-lit times) - parents should negotiate for restricting entertainment-screen time. Media and screen time is allowed but always within mutually defined and agreed limits.

Sticking to the schedule is important; regular reviews and rewards-consequences work effectively. The aim should be to help the adolescent practice self-regulation.

Parents being role models and limiting their own media use is vital. Repeated admonishments, and the dreaded "in our days" should be relegated to the family archives. Screen free zones in the house as well as screen free hours and days bring in a sense of control. Meal times and together times should be centered around mutual happiness and fun, and not turn into an audit hour for academics or inquisition for dodgy behaviours.

Screen time and screen schedules are important in this age of post pandemic schooling.

Make a schedule for the entire day, specifically accommodating the adolescents' other choices like outdoor sports, board games, dance, music and other hobbies, spending time with peers; and not just focusing on adding academic and limiting media time.

Parents need to educate themselves about social media and families including grandparents could make their social media policy that everyone follows. This is pertinent in view of the hybrid school and work life for children and parents, respectively.





IF PLAN A FAILS

Specifically, internet gaming addiction is now considered a mental health disorder. If your child compulsively uses media, craves for it, has lost control over its usage, gets violent when asked to stop its use, and continues to use despite adverse consequences such as fall in academic performance and loss of friendships, she is probably addicted to it. I have seen children throw umpteen tantrums and hit parents or even threaten their parents with all sort of self-harm like starvation, shunning studies totally, running away from home, or even suicide. It is important to remember that media addiction may be associated with other disorders such as attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), autism spectrum disorders, depression, and anxiety. This may mandate professional help. Media addiction can be treated by consulting mental health professionals. When you find one or more red flags as

mentioned, do consult with your pediatrician or a mental health professional at the earliest.

IS PUBLIC ACTION WARRANTED?

Yes, we do need public awareness and intervention in terms of easy availability of literature, resources and professional help. New Horizons ran a campaign with Chetana Insitute of Management called 'Limit My Screen Time' reaching out to the community a year before the pandemic; parents and children were counseled and asked to share their success stories to motivate others

Similarly, many organisations have put their best practices and success stories in the public domain. Impressive ambassadors like Steve Jobs have spoken out about the dangers of screen time. We need to support families and children to firstly understand, and then take a stand on media and screen time; not ban it. Media has become ubiquitous; and children are virtual natives. They will find more devious ways to access internet gaming, in the process endangering themselves. Policing will never work on someone who will always be a step ahead. What will work is when parents engage actively with children. Rather than a "Catch Me If You Can", it is better to do a "Pursuit of Happyness!" (Both excellent motion pictures to watch!)

RES JUDICATA

- The things have been decided.
- Once a case is decided between two parties, it can't be tried again within the same parties.

• In law, the immediate, not the remote cause of any event is regarded.

ACTUS NON FACIT REUM NISI MENS SIT REA

• The intent and the act must both concur to constitute the crime (MENS REA).

DEFINITION OF CHILD UNDER DIFFERENT ACTS

POCSO ACT 2012 < 18 years CHILD LABOUR ACT 1986 < 14 years THE JUVENILE JUSTICE ACT 2015 < 16 years FACTORIES ACT 1948 < 15 years

Many countries have 16 years or below – age of consent, like American states, Europe, Japan, Canada, Australia, China, Russia

Why the demand for reduction in the age under POCSO ACT?

- Get matured much earlier: exposed to so much of information.
- Juvenile Justice Act 2015, which allows the trial of 16 & 17 year old children as adults in respect of heinous offences.
- Many of the cases of sexual assault reported are dealing with 16-18 year old children consensual in nature.
- Where two minors engage in a consensual sexual relationship, in a paradox, they stand both as victims and perpetrators vis-àvis each other
- The act mandates Doctors to reveal the identities of their patients who are under the age of 18.

Sections of IPC related to Medical Profession

Sec. 29: Deals with documents

Sec. 52: Describes "Good faith"

Nothing is said to be done or believed in 'GOOD FAITH' which is done or believed without due care & attention

Sec. 80: Accident in doing lawful act

Nothing is an offence which is done by accident or misfortune & without any criminal intention or knowledge in the doing of a lawful act in a lawful manner by lawful means and with proper care and caution

Sec. 88: Act not intended to cause death, one by consent in good faith for person's benefit

Nothing which is not intended to cause death in an offense by reason of any harm which it may cause, or be intended by the doer to cause, or be known by the doer to be likely to cause, to any person for whose benefit it is done in good faith, and who has given consent

Sec. 89: It is similar to IPC Section 88 with the point of view of consent in case of children below 12 years & persons with a mental disorder where a guardian is authorized to give consent

Sec. 90: Related to consent

Sec. 92: Act done in good faith for benefit of a person without consent

Nothing is an offense by reason of any harm which it may cause to a person for whose benefit it is done in good faith, even without that person's consent, if the circumstances are such

Sec. 93: Communication made in good faith

No communication made in good faith is an offense by reason of any harm to the person to whom it is made if it is made for the benefit of that person

However, the Doctor would be prudent enough to ensure that the communication is based on verifiable facts of the case, in a good faith for the benefit of the person it was made and in view of the delicacy of the matter, conveyed appropriately in the presence of spouse/relative/guardian

Sec 176: Failure to inform police whenever essential

Sec. 269-271: Related to infectious disease & disobedience of a quarantine rule

Sec. 272-273: Related to adulteration of food and drinks

Sec. 274-276: Related to adulteration of drugs

Sec. 304-A: Deals with death caused by a negligent act

Sec. 306-309: Are related with abetment of suicides

Sec. 312-314: Related to causing miscarriage, abortion and hiding such facts

Sec. 315–316: Deals with act to prevent child being born alive or to cause it to die after birth

SOME IMPORTANT JUDGEMENT LINES

National Consumer Commission

Prescribing, advising or giving opinion without physically examining the patient except in emergencies is negligence.

Supreme Court of India

Absence of appropriate consultants whose presence is medically indicated during a surgery/procedure is negligence.

Supreme Court of India

Disregard procedural formalities and focus only on treatment of the patient in emergencies

Madhya Pradesh Consumer Commission

Not recording time of collecting sample and performing actual test in investigation reports could be construed as negligence

Delhi Consumer Commission

Patients can be allowed to have their own attendants/private nurses but only on receipt of a written request.

Andhra Pradesh Consumer Commission

Acting according to directions of the patient or attendants even if they may be doctors without being completely convinced is negligence

Madhya Pradesh Consumer Commission

Courts can grant compensation even if no real harm is caused to the patient and the negligence is merely technical.

Supreme Court of India

Do not give any cash or cheque to the patient in an out-of-court settlement without proper written agreement.

Andhra Pradesh Consumer Commission

In investigations like HIV/AIDS test, failure to state that the reports are not final and require further confirmation is negligence

Tamil Nadu Consumer Commission

Relying on clinical judgment only and not advising investigations at appropriate time when indicated is negligence

National Consumer Commission

Do not state the chances of success or failure in 'percentage' to the patient. Instead use terms like 'fair, normal or good'

वुहान, इटली, स्पेन व अमेरिकेची उदाहरणं समोर असुन देखीलिह आपण आपलं वेगळेपण दाखवून देऊ असे वाटत होते. त्यात बऱ्याच प्रमाणात यशस्वी सुद्धा झाल्यासारखे वाटतेय. वेळीच सर्व गोष्टींची दखल घेतल्याने परिस्थिती बरीच नियंत्रणात असली तरी अनेक कारणास्तव गंभीरता बरेच दिवस राहील असे वाटते.

सुरवातीला आम्ही N95 मास्क लावून रुग्ण बघत असु, मग फेस कव्हर (फेस शिल्ड्स) चालु केले. वारंवार हात धुणे चालूच होते, हाताला सॅनिटायझर लावणे चालूच होते, मग ग्लोव्हजिह घालून काम करायला लागलो. हॉस्पिटल मध्ये वारंवार डिसइन्फेक्शन(निर्जंतुकीकरण) चालूच होतं. पी. पी. इ. चा लवाजमा घालायचा म्हणजे प्रचंड उकडते. स्टेथोस्कोपिह धड कानाला लावता येत नाही व सहा-आठ तासांनी नवा पी. पी. इ. हे सर्व "सहनिह होत नाही व कोणाला सांगताहि येत नाही", अशा प्रकारचं. चष्मा सावरणं व त्यावरील फॉग, वॉश रूम ला जाणे... सगळ्या, अगदी सगळ्याच अडचणी.... आणि असेही, आम्ही तर आमच्याच हॉस्पिटल मध्ये काम करतोय... कोविड सेट अप मध्ये नाही. पण मग दिवसेंदिवस कोविड19 रुग्णसंख्या वाढायला लागल्यानंतर मात्र पी.पी.इ. चा चिलखत घालून रुग्ण पाहायला लागलो. परंतु पी.पी.इ. चा योग्य वापर करुन देखील काही आरोग्य कर्मचारी व डॉक्टरांना या विषाची बाधा झाल्याचे दिसून आल्यानंतर मात्र पायाखालची जमीन हलली.

आपल्याला कोरोना झाला तर?..... आपल्यामुळे आपल्या घरातल्याना झाला तर?.... आपण बाधित होऊन सिरीयस झालो तर?.... मरणाची भीती कोणाला वाटत नाही?? आम्हीही माणूसच आहोत कि... !!... जिल्ह्याच्या ठिकाणी रुग्णालय असल्यामुळे वर्षाकाठी दहा-बारा तरी अति सिरीयस रुग्ण बघत असल्यामुळे व शक्य होईल ते उपचार केल्यानंतरिह दगावलेले रुग्ण आम्ही नेहमीच पहात असतो आणि त्यामुळे जन्म, मृत्यू याचं आम्हाला फारसं अप्रूप वाटत नाहीच म्हणा!!...पण तरिही कोरोना होऊन आपण सिरीयस झालो व सगळं काही संपलं तर काय?.... या विचाराने झोप उडणं, डिप्रेशन येणं हे अगदी साहजिकच आहे.

यासंबंधी लहानपणीचा एक किस्सा मला आठवतो. पहिलीत असेन मी तेव्हा.... शाळेतून घरी येताना एका घरात खुप रडारड चालु होती.... जरा पुढे आलो तर एका तिरडीवर एका व्यक्तीला झोपवून चार लोक त्याला घेऊन चाललेले होते व बरेच लोक शांततेत मागुन चाललेले होते. काही ओकसाबोक्षी रडतही होते. काय झाले असेल काही कळत नव्हते... घरी येऊन आईला विचारले तर म्हणाली, ' केशव तात्या वारले' !!.... मला काही कळले नाही. पुन्हा आईला विचारले, 'म्हणजे काय?'..... ती म्हणाली, ' देवाघरी गेले'. आता वारणे, देवाघरी जाणे हे माझ्यासाठी तरी नवीन होते, कधी असा प्रसंग अनुभवला नव्हता. ती रात्र...... व पुढील दोन तीन दिवस अगदी बेचैनीचे गेले. ठिकशी झोपही लागली नाही. माणूस मरतो, देवाघरी जातो म्हणजे नेमकं काय होतं?..... हा विचार बरेच दिवस भेडसावत होता.

मग पुढील एक दोन वर्षात वार्धक्यामुळे गावातील दोन तीन माणसं वारली. तितकंसं काही वाटलं नाही, पण जेव्हा माझा बालपणीचा मित्र शिरीष साप चावल्यामुळे वारला तेव्हा मात्र मी खुप हादरलो. आम्ही रोज एकत्र खेळायचो, बागडायचो... मी फारच अस्वस्थ झालो. आईला पुन्हा विचारलं, 'तोच का देवाघरी गेला?'..... म्हणाली, ' आपल्या कर्मावर असतं सगळं..... कर्म वाईट असेल तर लवकरचं तिकीट निघतं !!'.... "पण शिरीष ने बिचाऱ्याने एवढ्या लहानपणी कोणाचं वाईट केलं होतं? मी आपलं न राहवून आईला विचारलं. मग म्हणाली "माझं डोकं खाऊ नको. आपल्या प्रारब्धावर अवलंबून असतं सर्व".... मग विचारलं, "प्रारब्ध म्हणजे काय? ".... म्हणाली, "नेहमी सर्वांचं चांगलं चिंतीत जा, चांगलं करीत जा, जमेल तेवढी लोकांना मदत, सेवा करत जा.... पुढच्या आयुष्यात फायदा होईल". मग या आयुष्याचं काय?..... चुकीचं काही नव्हतं !!....नंतर सर्वांकडून ऐकायला मिळत होतं.... शिरीषला जिल्ह्याच्या ठिकाणी उपचारासाठी नेले असते तर तो वाचला असता. (शिरीष अत्यवस्थ असताना त्याला सापाचं विष उतरवणाऱ्या मांत्रिकाकडे लोक घेऊन गेले होते). शाळेत पुढील वर्गात शिकत असताना शास्त्र - सामान्य विज्ञान या विषयात मला विशेष रुची वाटत गेली व "गावाकडे खुप डॉक्टर्स नसतात, तू झिपऱ्या डॉक्टर सारखा (आमच्या घरी होम व्हिजिट ला येणारे देसाई डॉक्टर)....डॉक्टर हो" असे बाबा गंमतीत म्हटल्याचे आठवते. डॉक्टर होण्याचे ठरवले, झालोही पण एम. बी. बी.एस. करत असताना पुतण्या ब्रेन ट्युमर ने वारल्यावर बालरोगतज्ञ व्हायचं ठरवलं. मनातली इच्छा पूर्ण झाली...... आईच्या सांगण्याप्रमाणे प्रारब्ध जपण्याचा प्रामाणिक प्रयत्न करतोय तेव्हापासून.

जीवन मरणाची कोडी अजुन चालूच आहेत. कथी हाती आलेली लढाई हरलोय, तर कथी जवळ जवळ हरलेली लढाई जिंकलोय. समजण्यापलीकडच्या गोष्टी-घटना आजही घडतात. एक किलोभराचं प्रीमॅचुअर बाळ आमच्याकडे वीसेक दिवस दाखल होते. बऱ्याच गुंतागुंतींबरोबर त्यास जंतुसंसर्गही होता. आजारातून सुटका होणं कठीण होतं. आर्थिक अडचण व खेड्यातील लोक असल्यामुळे पनवेल-मुंबईस न जाता तुम्हाला जमेल तेवढा इलाज करा असं सांगुन राहिले. पुढील दहा दिवसांत बाळ बरं झालं. अशाच प्रकारे एक धनुर्वात झालेलं, सात दिवसांचं माथाडी कामगाराचं बाळ एक महिन्यानंतर बरं झालं. तर याच्याच विरुद्ध एक कावीळ झालेलं व एक मेंदूज्वर झालेलं अशी दोन किशोरवयीन मुलं सुरक्षित असताना देखील व योग्य उपचार चालु असताना, दाखल झाल्याच्या दुसऱ्याच दिवशी अचानक सिरिअस होऊन दगावलेली उदाहरणं आहेत. वरील चारही रुग्णांबाबतीत काहीच स्पष्टीकरण माझ्याकडे नाही. सांगण्याचं तात्पर्य एकच... कोणतीही गोष्ट करण्याचा उद्देश प्रामाणिक असला पाहिजे. इथेच माझी आई सांगायची त्याप्रमाणे या सर्वांचा प्रारब्ध खुप महत्वाचा होता असं जर म्हटलं तर, "...........चांगलं करणं, चांगलं वागणं, प्रामाणिक राहणं, कर्त्तव्यतत्पर, परोपकारी राहणं या सर्व गोष्टी पुढील जन्मी दीर्घायुष्य देण्यासाठी खुप मोलाच्या असतील किंवा नसतील हे या जन्मी सांगणं अवघड आहे पण त्या सर्व अवलंबिल्या तर आजचे जगणे मात्र सुंदर होऊन जाईल."

जीवनावर खऱ्या अर्थाने प्रेम करायचे असेल तर जीवन अशा प्रकारे जगण्याचा या कोरोनाच्या महामारीत जर संकल्प केला तर कोणत्याही कोविड रुग्णालयात काम करण्याची, कोविड 19 रुग्णाची सेवा करण्याची आणि इतकंच काय यमाची किंवा अवेळी देवाघरी जाण्याचीिह भीती राहणार नाही. आज कोरोना आपल्यासमोर आहे. उद्या सुनामी आली तर? परवा अपघात झाला तर? तेरवा हार्ट ऍटॅक आला तर?...माणसाला मृत्यू अटळ आहे. कोरोना असो किंवाकाहि का असेना..... आणि हेच जर जीवनाचं अंतिम सत्य असेल तर या जन्मावर व या जगण्यावर प्रेम करायला शिकुयात !! कोणत्याही परिस्थितीत "आय लव्ह यु जिंदगी" असं म्हणायला शिकुयात !!

HINA—What's in the name?

HINA is an acronym for HIgh-risk Newborn Assessment and follow-up. It is a structured program for pediatricians launched by the Maharashtra IAP team in 2022 through two online workshops. Fifty-seven pediatricians from all Maharashtra regions and five states of India have participated in it. In addition, MAHAIAP is conducting an offline preconference workshop in November at Mahapedicon Nashik. It's a dream come true envisioned by the dynamic MAHAIAP office bearers of 2022.

The idea.

First, let me take you through how the HINA idea got conceptualized. I have been part of a Neonatal Intensive Care team -

-for over eight years in Jalgaon, Maharashtra. Though we are doing good work in caring about sick neonates, a lot more needs to be done for NICU graduates in follow-up care, after discharge, about their specific needs. To begin with, limited parent awareness, time constraints, and lack of formal training were barriers for me. In January 2022, I got nominated as an EB member for North Maharashtra. The dynamic duo of Honorable President Dr. Hemant Gangolia Honorable Secretary General Dr. Amol Pawar allowed me to work on this area. They suggested developing structured programs for pediatricians and helped me get a team of subject experts with pan-Maharashtra representation. Both were troubleshooters for me at all stages.



HINA PROGRAM

The team and the process.

Fortunately, I got equally passionate team members to materialize the concept of HINA into a structured program. From the beginning, we decided to formulate the program on three fundamental "SIP" principles. HINA program should be –

Scientific and supported by peer-reviewed literature, immediately implementable from the next day for a pediatrician who looks after high-risk newborns and parents/family-centered as parents are experts in a child's life. Over eight months, we regularly met online every Tuesday and Friday to review the program's progress. In addition, we formulated a WhatsApp group and had lots of back-and-forth communication among us.

The medical assessment screening and growth monitoring part is looked after by Dr. Anil Kumar Khamkar, a senior neonatologist from Pune. Dr. Kashmiri Badbade, a renowned developmental pediatrician from Itchalkarnji, contributed to the neurological assessment. She came up with amazing demonstrative videos for tone assessment. which added Great Value to the content. Dr. Dinesh Saroj from Nagpur and Dr. Ashwini Marathi from Thane, renowned developmental pediatricians, handled the developmental monitoring aspect of the module very effectively. They were also crucial in designing registration forms, pretest-posttest, and feedback forms.

Special mention to Dr. Ashwini Marathi and Dr. Leela Lobo, Ummeed CDC Mumbai, for getting the tedious job of printing HINA kits. Each participant received one KIT with 3 HINA proformas, an IGMCD sheet, and an interactive FLIP chart for easy navigation through IGMCD. The International Guide for Monitoring Child Development (IGMCD) is a developmental monitoring tool for children under 3.5 years of age that has been standardized and validated in India.

We were fortunate to get expert reviewers for the HINA program. Prof Dr. Satinder Aneja madam, former HOD department of pediatrics, LHMC Delhi, with extensive experience in child neurology, and Prof Dr. Pradeep Suryawanshi sir, HOD department of neonatology BVUMC and Sahyadri Hospital Pune, author of NNF guidelines for high-risk newborn assessment and follow-up. Their input helped us to make the HINA module more meaningful and user-friendly.

The amazing IGMCD training team of developmental pediatricians from Ummeed child development Centre Mumbai, Dr. Vibha Krishnamurthy, Dr. Rupa Srinivasan, and Dr. Leera Lobo helped in making the HINA program a comprehensive program. Moreover, we are indebted to Prof Dr. Ilgi Ertem, ex- HOD developmental pediatrics Turkey university, for permitting and providing a one-day online IGMCD tool in a brief period.

The solid supporting team of Dr. Neha Singh (MOC), Dr. Vishal Raut (Tech wizard), and Mrs. Pallavi Dharmadhikari (Virtual platform support) ensured the smooth sailing of the ship when we were live streaming.

Windmill model of HINA

Team HINA envisions its care delivery model as a dynamic Windmill with four fans and a central button. Four fans represent medical assessment with screenings, growth monitoring, neurological examination, and developmental monitoring.





HINA PROGRAM

At the center, documentation, and counseling aim to provide hope, support, and family-centered care. In addition, the ongoing developmental support and nurturing care will keep the windmill dynamically moving system.

HINA Package

- Online training on managing HR neonates in limited resource situation
- Resources for pediatricians articles, guidelines, and flyers
- Form 1: Predischarge checklist
- Form 2: HINA flow chart
- Form 3: HINA visit proforma: for medical, neurological, and developmental findings and plan of care documentation
- Form 4: IGMCD tool form for development monitoring
- IGMCD tool interactive flip chart

We got overwhelming responses from participants from all regions of Maharashtra and other states. We all worked to make this training program scientific, immediately applicable, and family centered. Finally, the subsequent follow-up and responses from participants will let us know how far we succeeded.

I will conclude with Raffi's quote," When we change the story's beginning, we change the whole story." So let this program be the change we are looking to change the story of our high-risk newborns.

All glory to MAHAIAP and the Indian Academy of Pediatrics.





ANXIETY IN CHILDREN

Childhood is supposedly the most enjoyable and stress-free period of life. Traditionally, this period of life is considered to be full of fun, happiness, energy and lot of play and what not! The adult mind always remembers childhood fondly and fails to understand that even childhood can be a stressful period of life. Yes, it is true! The adult mind fails to remember its own childhood anxieties.

Many children suffer from stress, anxiety and fear due to variety of reasons. The reasons could be varied, ranging from common causes like physical, mental or sexual abuse or less known causes like stress due to different reasons. These include anxiety in coping with academics, facing certain social situations or may be the fear of some person, object or situation.


Childhood anxiety disorders and phobic anxiety disorders of childhood are well-recognized clinical entities which are not diagnosed properly because of lack of awareness and lack of acceptance.

Growing up period from early childhood to adolescence is filled with challenges. These varied challenges include coping up with family environment, teachers and school environment, peer group, academics etc. Maladjustments in any of these can lead to anxiety in a child. In addition, there are certain psychological conditions and states in which child is genetically prone to getting anxious. In this the situation may not be challenging but still because of the typical mindset of the child, they may feel anxious.

Various common conditions which can lead to anxiety and insecurity in children are:

- Disturbed family unit and environment
- Rigid disciplinary methods adopted by the parents
- Difficulties in adjustments with school environment and academics
- Peer pressure and school bullying
- Frequent exposure to fear generating stimulus
- Exaggerated and repeated stories, threatening about ghosts, dark areas or animals etc.

Some childhood developmental disorders like Learning Disability, Pervasive Developmental Disorders, Hyperactivity, Conduct Disorder are also associated with fear and anxiety. Certain categories which are medically categorized as 'Emotional Disorders with Specific Onset' in children include-



- Phobic Anxiety Disorder
- Social Anxiety Disorder
- Sibling Rivalry Disorder

KUCH TO LOG KAHEGE! Logo ka Kaam Hai Kehna!



Whether you are fat or thin, lean or bulky, tall or short body shaming has not spared anyone. Because society has always had the image of what's called "Ideal".

The above ones are a few common statements that we hear in our day to day lives and especially from our so-called near and dear ones, which hurt and affect us the most.



[&]quot;Kha khake phool gayi hain gubbare jaise"

[&]quot;Aree kuch khate kyu nahi, biwi khana nahi banati kya"

[&]quot;Lagta hain saara khana khud hi kha jaati hain tabhi bachcha itna dubla patla hain"

[&]quot;Hanger ke upar kapde taange hue hain"

[&]quot;Gym kyu nahi jaate, lazy ho"

[&]quot;Gol Gappe ki tarah phul gaye ho"

[&]quot;Aree ek fukh maaro udh jaayegi, kuch khati kyu nahi"

[&]quot;Aur kitni dubli hogi ek din gayab hi ho jaayegi"

[&]quot;Kitni choti hai OR Kitni Lambhi Hai... shadi ke liye larka nahi milega."

[&]quot;apna kuch karti kyu nahi"

[&]quot;she's too curvy, she should lose weight"

[&]quot;she's too thin, she has no curves"

These days, people do not seem to find anything wrong in making fun of someone else's body, and sure enough, it is the 'fat' person who is the preferred target compared to the thin and 'short' one preferred to the 'tall'. Shockingly, some people think/believe that making a person feel ashamed of their bodies is an effective way of motivating them to transform themselves and that they will work even harder to achieve this miracle. But these Body Shaming comments leave a lasting impact/ impression on those who receive them; not just mentally but physically too.


Also, when one is continuously body-shamed it lowers one's self-confidence & mental stress causes more harm and leads to health disorders

As per the results published in medical journal of Obesity, it indicated that those who had negative perception of their weight due to body shaming and other negative stereotypes related to weight, were three times as likely to develop diabetes, heart diseases, and stroke, in comparison to individuals with similar weights and body types who did not carry those same negative self-thoughts.

The next question that comes to my mind is why people body shame others? It's mainly because we live in a society where the focus is stronger on appearance than anything else. Society and social media have contributed in creating this myth of the "perfect idyllic body" as represented by a woman with the size-zero figure or the man who has six-pack abs. Our culture loves thin, whether it be in print ads, movies or real life. It doesn't matter if the person is fit or healthy, he or she should be thin. It's not necessary that someone who is thin is the fittest of all, he could be like a 'khokla' body having no stamina at all and having poor metabolism and prone to diseases. Whereas someone who is obese need not be unhealthy all the times.

Every individual is different and have different body structure & a different metabolism rate. There could be a lot of reasons behind this like hormones & genes play a major role. Some people have such a good metabolic rate that no matter how much calories they eat they don't gain weight and some have poor metabolism that even if they eat less, they are obese and can't shed that extra weight off. You must have heard people saying that "Main jitna bhi kha lu weight badhta hi nahi hain "or "Main toh khana dekhke ya smell karke hi mota ho jata hoon"

Every child has his or her insecurities, which are further amplified by the act of body shaming





Those who clearly intend to hurt will never stop targeting the body image with nasty comments, but what we need to understand here is that nobody chooses the body they have, especially an unfit body. Every individual wants to have a perfect body shape and look beautiful. No one wants to look ugly, but has anyone ever thought that more than weight loss/weight gain - Am I Fit? Am I Healthy? Do I have the stamina? Am I prone to any diseases?

If someone is unhealthy, tell them how to change that, show them how they can become fit, and encourage them to take that road, rather than just criticizing them, or even making fun of them. Discrimination and shaming only cause stress and makes any person feel bad.

. If someone is already overweight, this stress can actually make them eat more and more, and consequently, gain even more weight. The harmful effects of body shaming go beyond just increase in weight. Here are some of the other major risks that body shaming presents:

Depression:

People who are the target of body shaming due to weight are at higher risk of depression and other mental illnesses (no surprises there).

One study found 94 percent of all teenage girls, and 64 percent of teenage boys have been shamed for the way their body looks.

Eating disorders:

Body shaming is linked to an increased risk of eating disorders, such as binge eating disorder. One tends to eat more and especially junk food & stress leads to an increase in weight too.

Reduced self-esteem:

People with weight issues who are soft targets for body shamers, end up with



major self-esteem issues. With no one to defend them, and unable to defend themselves, such people may become loners, avoiding any kind of social interaction, be it merely going out with friends. It also creates hatred for the person passing such comments

Body shaming is a practice that must be avoided at all costs. No one is perfect, and if we remember our own flaws, we will learn to motivate, support, and encourage each other. Body shaming is an issue that will not be solved unless everyone learns to accept their own bodies, and until the myth of the 'perfect body' comes to an end

At times this body shaming isn't restricted to body shape, people also comment on the skin colour of a person. This is again very humiliating for a person. Sometimes this comparison is within siblings (one is fair & other is dark). Even a child & mother is compared for their skin colour. People also comment that you must have not eaten coconut or had Kesar (saffron) during pregnancy so the child isn't fair & white

What has these things got to do with the colour of the child? Why does everyone run behind fairness? When a mother is blamed for not breastfeeding her child, is another act of body shaming. She is even told that if you don't breastfeed then there shall be no bond between the mother & child. Why tell such things to a mother?

Has anyone thought how the mother shall feel on hearing such harsh statements? Firstly it's a new journey for her, her body goes through tremendous changes. There could be reasons behind not being able to breastfeed – may be not enough milk production or some complication. No mother would want this. Why can't we support and stand by each other rather than criticizing & passing such nasty comments?

Don't compare your bodies with someone else's. Let's embrace our body type. "You are more than the way you look". Love your body, Love yourself. And also, don't let others compare you to someone else. Focus more on living a healthy life than mere weight loss. These are some ways in which you can support yourselves against these practices

Remember when you judge a person by her appearance, it doesn't define him or her. It defines YOU!!

कोल्हापूर, ता. १७ : लहान मुलांमध्ये हगवण किंवा अतिसाराच्या आजारात बाल मृत्यू होण्याचे प्रमाण १३ टक्क्यांवर आहे. अशा स्थितीत 'जलसंजीवनी'च्या वापराने शुष्कता टाळून बाल मृत्यूचे प्रमाण कमी करता येणे शक्य आहे. याबाबत जागृती करण्याचा भाग म्हणून भारतीय बालरोगतज्ज्ञ संघटनेतर्फे २५ ते ३१ जुलै या काळात दरवर्षी 'जागतिक जलसंजीवनी आठवडा' व २९ जुलै हा 'जलसंजीवनी दिवस' पाळला जाणार आहे, अशी माहिती बालरोगतज्ज्ञ संघटनेचे सल्लागार बालरोगतज्ज्ञ डॉ. शिशिर मिरगुंडे यांनी दिली.




















Social Activities and Achievments

Infantile Spasms is not uncommon

HIS is a common scenario we come across in our OPD. One 7 months old girl came to my OPD for not looking at parents when called, not holding her head which is expected at 4 – 5 months of age. One additional thing was that she used to get startle and frightened like episodes for unknown reason. This used to be followed by excess crying, screaming and irritability. This used to happen multiple times a day particularly after getting up from sleep. This baby was in NICL for more than 10 days for fits because of low blood sugar that was noticed or

It's the common scenario we com across. The reason for mentioning th scenario is the frightening episodes th basically a form of seizures or fits that

are called as intantile spasms. Infantile spasms are a special form of epilepy seen in infants that is in the kids who are usually less than 1 year of age. These are the fits that appear jus like startle or jerk and practically always its mistaken by the parents as a frighten ing episode rather than seizures. But hey have big impact on overall compitive or mental development of the kid. not treated properly and compiletely the kid may be mentally delayed permanen

So Infantile Spasms is a neurological emergency and urgent attention toward its confirmation of diagnosis and management is must. EEG (electroen cephalography) is the investigation o choice for diagnosis. They have grossh abnormal and signature EEG pattern known as Hypsarrythmia. So once the diagnosis is confirmed certain medications are specially used for this type of seizures and these are different from the routine anti-epileptic drugs. One of the medications used is a drug called Vigabatrin along with steroids. Vigabatrin has become easily available in India in just last 1.5 – 2 years and that has made management of infantile spasms quite easy.

So, message to remember here is particularly in those kids with delayed development or if there is a history of NICU stay and if you notice jerking or frightening like episodes inform you pediatrician immediately. Prompt action may help your kid to achieve its full poscible developmental potential.
